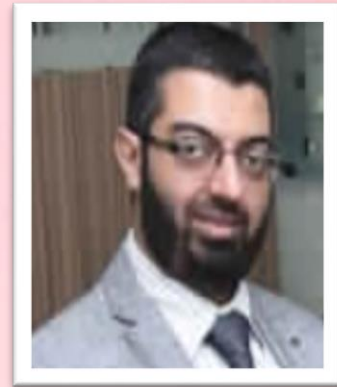

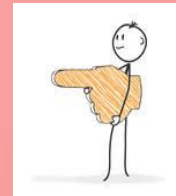

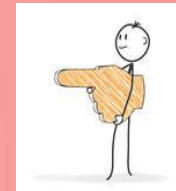

Cause they're dried and gone and shall never return.

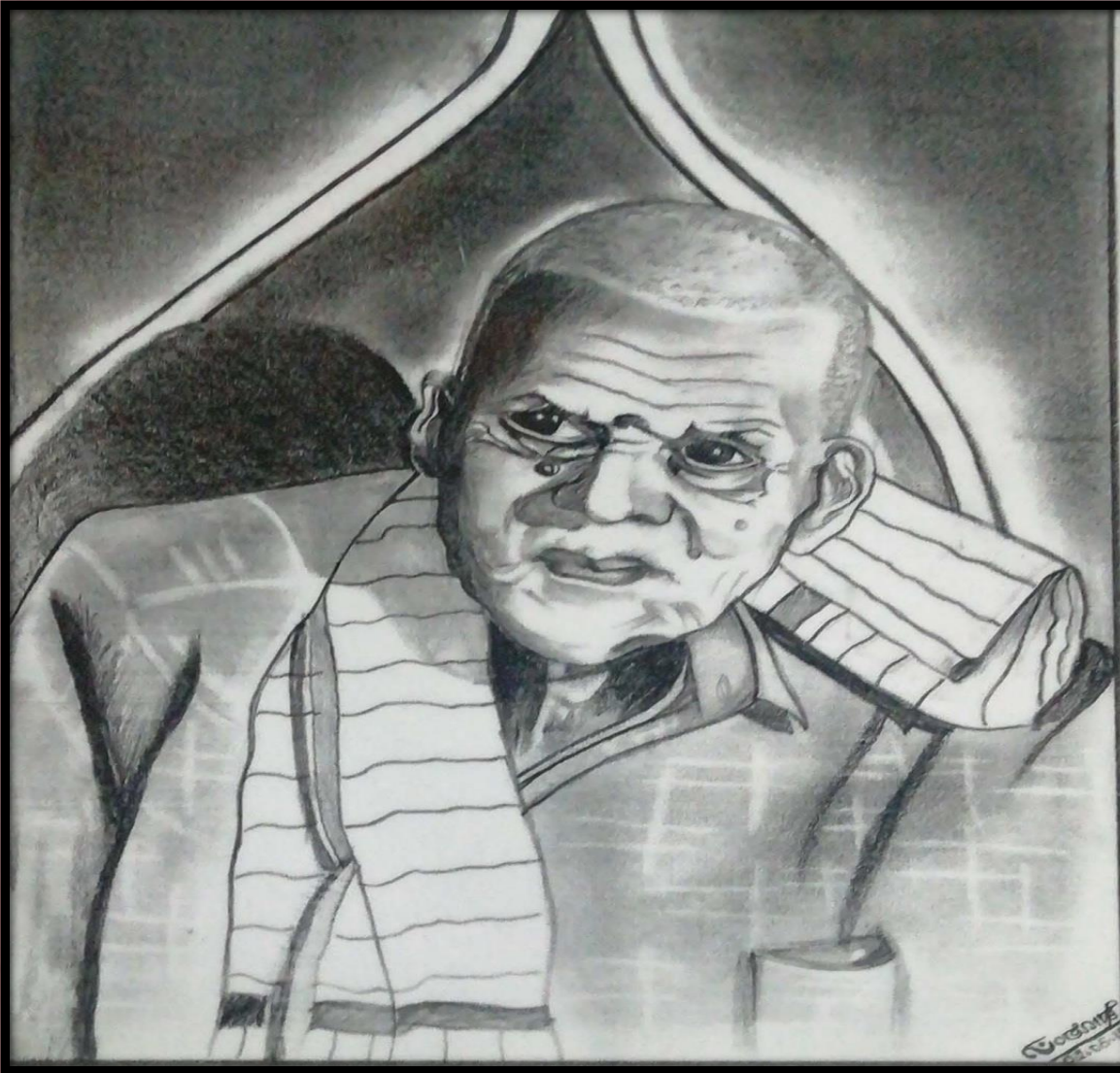
I now reached the summit-

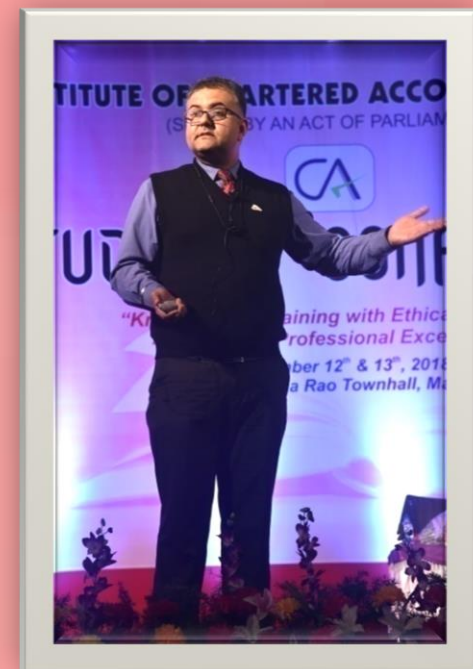
